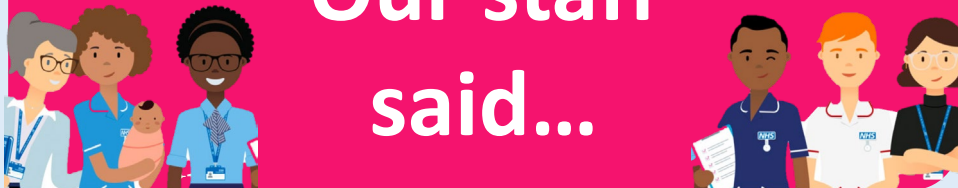

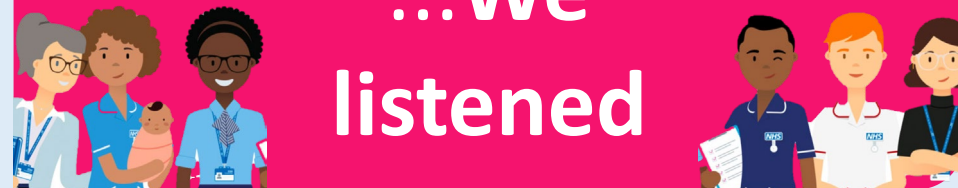
Staff highlighted they are reluctant to complete QIS training as there are no financial or career progression incentives.

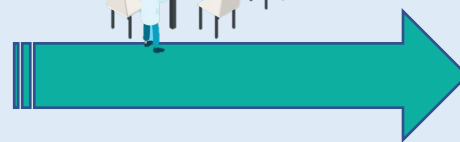
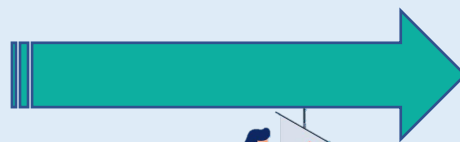
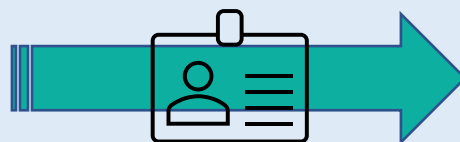
Suggestion of one ward clerk working in the atrium overnight for the whole of Women and Children's.



As part of the Ockenden business case, we are looking at cost options to move staff to Band 6 if they complete the QIS training.



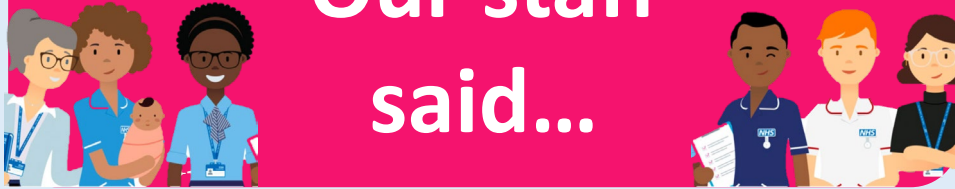
