BAF risk 3 rating has increased from 12 to 16 in light of the current pause of some training. To ensure the Trust operates within its financial means, a review is being conducted to assess which services may no longer be affordable and sustainable without reliance on bank and agency staff. With service reviews taking place, attention needs to be given to the importance of communications for both patients and staff.
